

Completing the Online Application Form – Category A

Name	Type in your name as it appears in your NRIC/ Passport.
Identity Card/ Foreign Identification	For Singaporean and Singapore Permanent Resident, please type an 'S' in front of your NRIC number.
Correspondence Address	For Singapore address, you only need to type in your block/house number, unit number and postal code as the system will capture the full address. For foreign address, please type in the complete address in the box provided.
Email Address, Home Telephone No., Contact Telephone No. & Hand phone No.	It is important that you provide an e-mail address and at least one contact number so that we can contact you if more information is required or we may need to contact you for an interview where necessary.
Gender and Marital Status	Use the drop-lists to select your gender and marital status.
Date of Birth	The date of birth should be entered in this format: e.g. 21-Jan-1979.
Race; Nationality and Singapore Permanent Resident	Use the drop-lists to select your race and nationality. If you are a Singapore Permanent Resident, click "Yes' using the drop-list.
Full-Time National Service in Singapore	Male Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents must complete this section. It is important to fill in the correct Enlistment and Operationally Ready Dates (in this format DD-MON-YYYY) so that we will know which admission year to reserve if you are offered a place. If you are unsure of the exact date, please provide us with the estimated dates and provide us the correct information via email later.

GCE 'O' Level	Use the drop-list to select your examination type and indicate the years of attempt(s) made (e.g. 1985).
GCE 'A' Level	It is important that you provide all the information as required for this section.
SAT I	SAT I is no longer a requirement from academic year 2006 onwards.
Mature Applicant	<p>A Mature applicant is an applicant who is at least 25 years of age with at least 4 years of work experience (after graduation from college) as of 1 July of the admission year. A mature applicant is required to fill in this section by providing the date(s) he/she joined and/or resigned from a company. Please note that National Service and Industrial Attachment are NOT considered as work experience. Please leave blank for 'Date resigned' if you have not resigned from your present job.</p> <p>A Mature Applicant must submit a Personal Statement of not more than 200 words on-line and also 2 Referee Reports from at least one employer using the downloadable Employer's Referral Form. Referrals must be at supervisory level and above.</p> <p>The completed Employer's Referral Form is to be sealed and sent to the Office of Admissions and Financial Aid.</p> <p>The links for submission of Personal Statement and downloading of the Employer's Referral Form will appear in the Application Status Menu after you have successfully submitted your on-line application.</p>

<p>Choices of Programme</p>	<p>Use the drop-lists to indicate your choice of programme for NTU. You can select up to 5 choices. If you have indicated Arts(Education) and/or Science(Education) as one of your choices, you MUST also complete the on-line Application for Teacher form. Click the Application for Teacher button which appears at the bottom of the Document Submission/ Payment Menu page to access the on-line form. <p>Non-Academic Achievements</p>	<p>Applicants with other talents/achievements could fill up Section A & B if you wish to use the talents/achievements in consideration for your achievement.</p>
<p>Scholarship Application</p>	<p>The link to apply for scholarship is found at the end of the application for admission. As the scholarship is offered to students admitted to NTU, applicants who wish to be considered for scholarship have to complete the on-line application for admission. There is no hard copy for scholarship application. Applicants will be required to submit an appraisal form and write 1 essay between 250-300 words.</p>
<p>Criminal Offence</p>	<p>Use the drop-list to indicate whether you have ever been convicted of a criminal offence by a court of law of any country and specify the crime committed.</p>
<p>Disabilities & Special Needs</p>	<p>Please indicate Yes/No if you have any communicable diseases, mental illness, colour blindness or etc and specify your disabilities and special needs required.</p>
